WORK ON STONNALL'S NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 2024

A neighbourhood plan is a statutory document that gives communities the power to shape the development of their local area. It's important because it allows communities to:

- Have a say where new homes, shops, offices are built and what they should look like
- Influence development and the use and development of land in their area
- **Strengthen communities** by coming together to make planning decisions and deliver a collective vision for their area
- **Fund community infrastructure,** use money raised from developers to fund infrastructure like new roads, schools, and parks

Stonnall's current plan was adopted in 2016 and now being re-freshed by local residents, Shenstone Parish Council, a Planning Consultancy and local Councillors.

All work on the plan is aimed at getting the highest level of involvement, input and consultation with residents.

We therefore have two 'anonymous' surveys that we would love to see input from as many residents as possible.

- 1) Community Survey on how residents feel about Stonnall (all individual residents invited to complete)
- 2) A Housing Needs Survey (one response per household required)
